3 Precept

A letter had been received from Ceredigion County Council in respect of the 2018/19 precept arrangements. Due to additional financial pressures being placed on volunteers in our community as a consequence of the withdrawal of financial support from the Council, the Community Council has witnessed an increase request for support from organisations to sustain services to Llandysul and the Community. Following a lengthy discussion it was decided to raise the precept by 5%. Councillors voted for 2 keeping the precept as it is and 5 voted for the increase.
