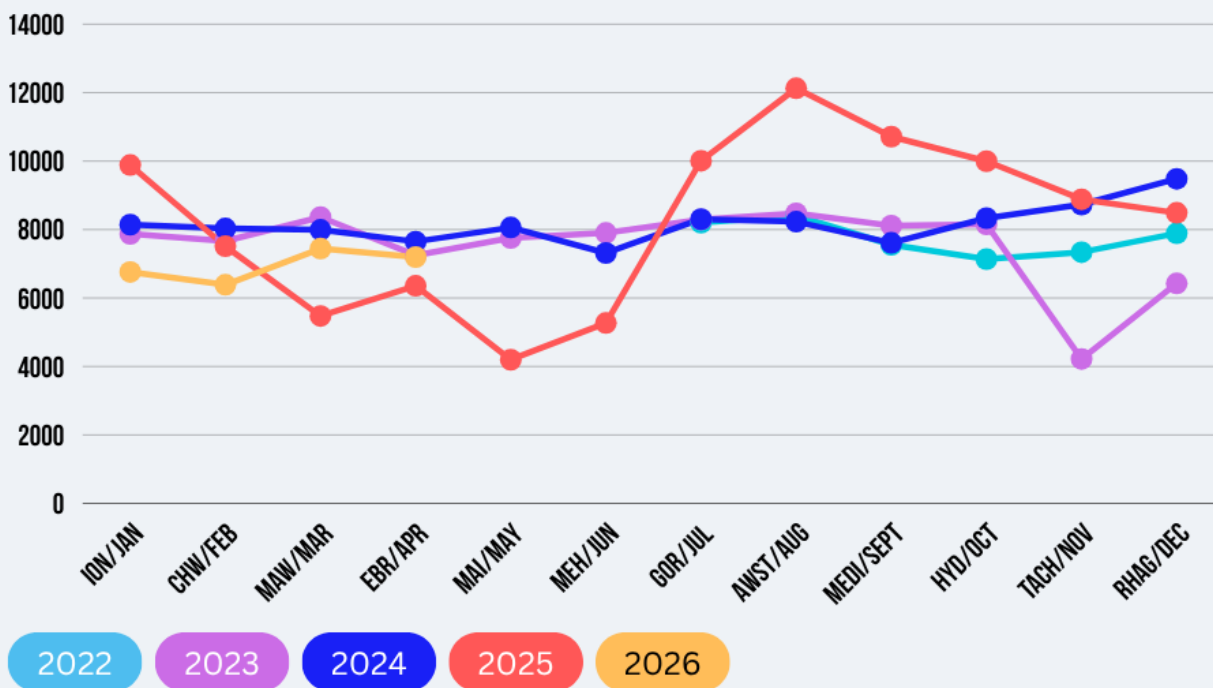


LLANDYSUL FOOTFALL



2025 Only 2 access points working from January to June
 2023 November and December incomplete data due to technical issues.

April recorded **7,196 visitors** recorded by Llandysul Town Wi-Fi.

A total of 7,196 visitors were recorded by the Llandysul Town Wi-Fi network during April 2026. While slightly lower than March’s figure of 7,442, visitor numbers remained strong and continued the positive trend seen so far this year.

The busiest day of the month was Tuesday 21 April, when 290 visitors were recorded — the highest single-day figure seen so far in 2026. This suggests strong post-Easter activity within the town centre.

These figures are broadly consistent with March and continue to demonstrate regular repeat use of the town centre by local people and returning visitors.

Several events and seasonal factors are likely to have contributed to activity levels during April, including:

- The Easter Bank Holiday weekend
- Schools returning after the holidays
- The official launch of the Teifi Valley Trail at Y Porth on Saturday 25 April

The Teifi Valley Trail launch in particular brought additional visitors into the town and highlighted Llandysul’s growing role as a destination for walking, tourism and outdoor activity.

Overall, the April figures indicate that Llandysul continues to benefit from strong community use, seasonal activity and events which help attract visitors into the town.

While the Wi-Fi data captures only part of overall activity, it offers a consistent and reliable indicator of change over time.

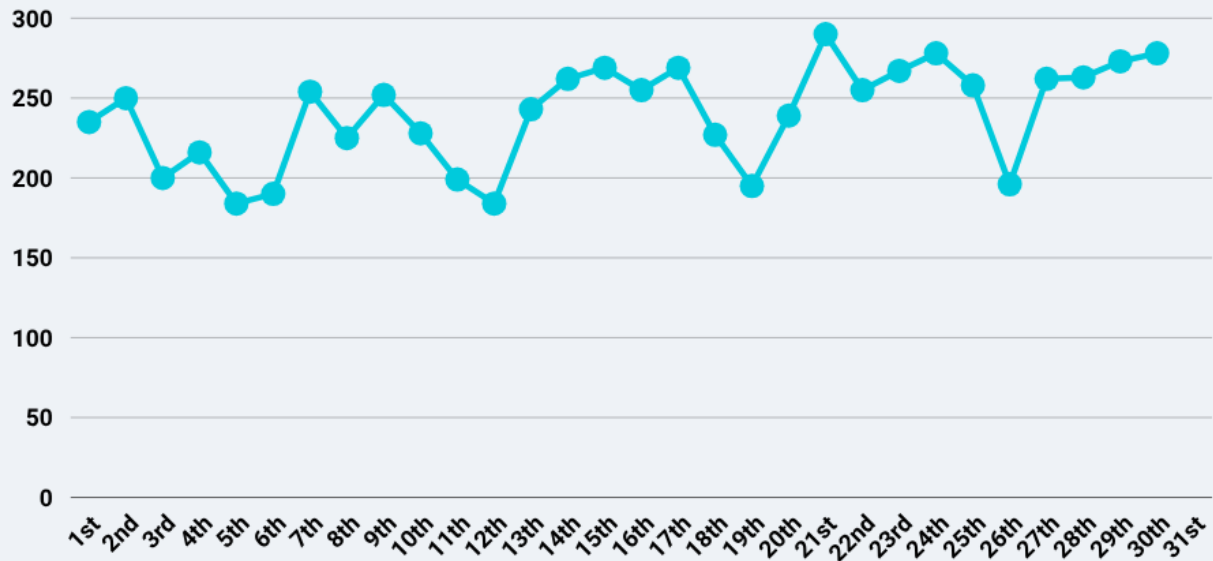
1. Not every device can be detected, so the amount counted is not exact and there are not enough access points to cover the town. However, the data collected might spot any trends over time or identify areas of the town that are particularly popular with visitors.

Weekly visitors have visited in at least two distinct weeks out of the past four, but not frequently enough to be considered daily visitors.

Monthly visitors have visited at least once before.
